


Normal - Range

#### normal

I. usual, typical, or expected:A normal working week is 40 hours.



2. the usual state, level, or amount: Thankfully, her heartbeat returned to normal.



#### obtain

I. to get something that you want, especially through your own effort, skill, or work [= get]

After eight years of study, he obtained a PhD in medicine.



2. if a situation, system, or rule obtains, it continues to exist:

Because of the change in company policy, these conditions no longer obtain.



# participate

I. to take part in an activity or event:

Students who participate in class learn more quickly than those who do not.



Participate is <u>never</u> followed directly by a <u>noun</u>. Say that you <u>participate in</u> something:

Citizens can participate in an election

#### Ways Citizens can Participate

Voting - On election day people can participate by turning out to vote for the Presidential candidate of their choice.

e.g. In federal elections, you vote for the President every 4 years and Congress every 2 years.

# perceive

I. to understand or think of something or someone in a particular way

Often what is perceived to be aggression is simply fear.




2. to notice, see, or recognize something

Cats are not able to perceive color.



### positive

I. if you are positive about things, you are hopeful and confident, and think about what is good in a situation rather than what is bad [≠ negative]
You've got to be more positive about your work.



2. a quality or feature that is good or useful [# negative]:

There are many positive benefits to exercise.



### potential

I. likely to develop into a particular type of person or thing in the future [= possible]

The potential presidential candidates have been debating throughout the spring.



2. the possibility that something will develop in a particular way, or have a particular effect

She has the potential to develop into a great athlete.



### previous

- I. having happened or existed before the event, time, or thing that you are talking about now:

  She has two children from a previous marriage.
- 2. The one that came immediately before the one you are talking about now:

I had met them the previous day.





## primary

I. most important [= main]:

Many of the villagers rely on fishing as their primary source of income.



2. happening or developing before other things:

Children who receive a good education in their primary years do better later in life.



# purchase

I. to buy something:
You can purchase insurance on-line.



2. something you buy, or the act of buying it:

She paid for her purchases and left.



#### range

I. a number of people or things that are all different, but are all of the same general type

The drug is affective against a wide range of bacteria.

2. to include a variety of different things or people in addition to those mentioned

The show had a massive audience, ranging from children to grandparents.
